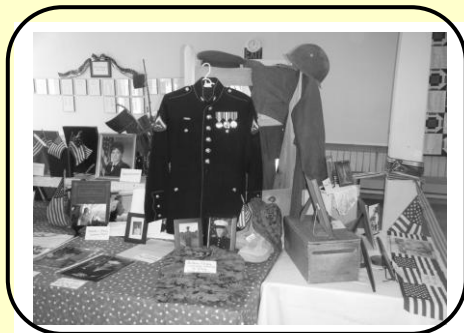

## LANGDON HERITAGE COMMISSION

The Langdon Heritage Commission was formed in 2007 to properly recognize, use, preserve and protect our significant, historic, cultural, natural and aesthetic assets. In so doing we not only preserve our buildings and land, we build community connections, establish trust among diverse groups, encourage volunteerism, develop community leaders and enhance the livability of our community. The Langdon Heritage Commission is a civic organization within the municipal structure of the Town of Langdon NH

### Historic Sites in Langdon:

- **Langdon Town Hall / Meetinghouse**, 4 Walker Hill Road, Built 1801-1803 when Thomas Jefferson was president. It is the site of the most consecutive town hall meetings in all of NH, 207 meetings to date. Tours are available by appointment.
- **Prentiss Covered Bridge**, Old Cheshire Turnpike, ½ miles south of NH Rte 12A, spans over Great Brook. Built 1791, Smallest covered bridge in NH, 34'6" long,
- **McDermott Covered Bridge**, North of Rte. 123, 2 miles north of Alstead Village, spans over Cold River. Built 1869.
- **Historic Langdon Upper Cemetery**, Holden Hill Rd, located next to the Langdon Meetinghouse at 4 Walker Hill Road, Langdon, NH 03602. Established approximately 1790. Memorial Day Services are held each year to honor our servicemen.
- **Langdon Congregational Church**, Village Road – Built in 1842.
- **Lower Langdon Cemetery**, Lower Cemetery Road – Established in 1795
